Code of Conduct:

Every student is expected to behave in a disciplined, responsible and courteous manner when on studio grounds, and when participating in studio activities and performances, talking about the company in a public manor as well as dress appropriately and neatly for class. Any use of drugs, alcohol or tobacco products will not be tolerated on studio grounds. The Director reserves the right to suspend or expel any student at any time if his or her attitude, conduct, language, appearance, attendance, payment record or the like is judged unsatisfactory. Any consistently disruptive or inappropriate conduct or behavior will be grounds for dismissal at the discretion of the Director. In the event of a dismissal, all tuition and/or recital monies paid to Red's Star Dance Company on behalf of a discharged student will be forfeited. Parents/Guardians also must respect the rules, policies and procedures of Red's Star Dance Company and abide by driving slow and cautious around the building and refraining from any rude or aggressive behavior toward any other RSDC student, family member or staff member. Any and all incidents should be reported immediately to the Director.
